Surrey has one of the highest car ownership rates in the country with traffic growth in the county expected to rise by more than a third of its current rate in the next fifteen years.

As a major employer in Surrey, the Enterprise Centre has a significant impact on the environment, quality of life and economic diversity of the local area. One of the main impacts arises from the use of transport by the users and visitors of Companies occupying the Centre.

The impacts caused by transport are of major concern and include pollution and congestion, annoyance of neighbours through on-street parking, the costs of maintaining and administering car-parks and the loss of staff time due to congestion and parking difficulties.

The owners of The Enterprise Centre will commit to:

- Reduce environmental, social and business impacts associated with transport use by reducing unnecessary journeys to and from the Centre by single occupancy vehicles.
- Implement measures which will maximise the number of people choosing to walk, cycle, travel by public transport, car share or use other alternatives.
 - Raise awareness of travel choices.
- Monitor and measure progress towards targets.

CYCLING & WALKING

Cycling and walking are major components of The Enterprise Centre Travel Plan, for many people who live within a reasonable distance of TEC they provide a healthy and inexpensive means of travelling to and from work.

There are 20 cycle racks adjoining the main entrance, protected by the overhanging front canopy. A shower and changing facilities have been provided within the common areas for the use and comfort of staff employed at TEC.

Walking is a great cardiovascular activity, requiring only thirty minutes three times a week to obtain a good level of cardiovascular fitness.

CAR SHARING

The UK has the worst congestion, longest commuting time, second highest road utilisation and highest car ownership in the EU.

The UK's traffic situation has led to significant social, economic and environmental costs :

- Traffic jams cost the economy £5 billion every year in lost productivity
- 90% of London air pollution is caused by road traffic
- There are 38 million empty seats on the road every day
